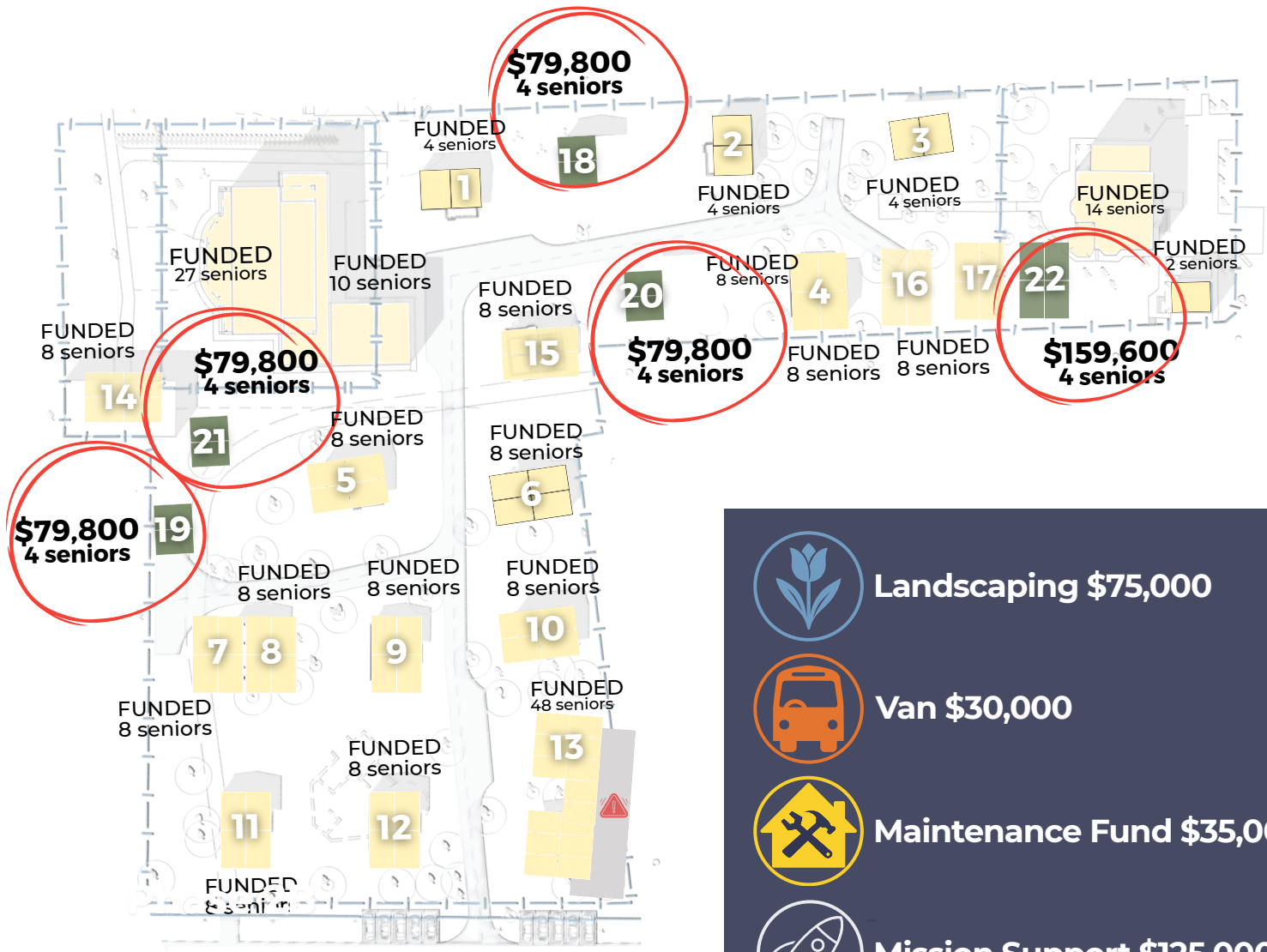

# Leonid and Tetiana

We are Leonid (83) and Tetiana (81), and we lived in Bakhmut for over 50 years. We were proud of the life we built — a home, a community, and a sense of belonging. But the war tore all of that away.

We stayed as long as we could, until the food ran out, the pensions stopped, and the gas, electricity, and water were all gone. Rockets fell daily.

Now, we live in heaven. We have only been here a few weeks, but we have made new friends and have a beautiful place of our own.

**INTERESTS:** Tetiana is a movie enthusiast, especially when it comes to comedies. Years ago, she delighted in knitting and cooking—her goulash and cutlets were favorites with everyone.

Leonid has always been athletic; at 50, he won a 100-meter sprint trophy. He loves to garden. They enjoy long walks and the peace of quiet moments together. Above all, they pray for the safe return of their grandson Viktor, who is serving at the front.



# Liudmyla

My name is Liudmyla, and I'm 77 years old. I'm a widow. My husband and I lived in the city of Toretsk in the Donetsk region. But in October 2022, as the shelling grew unbearable and we lost gas, electricity, and water, we had no choice but to leave.

Shortly after our arrival at the shelter, my husband passed away. I was left alone — grieving, disoriented, and once again displaced. My son died of COVID-19. My other son suffered a heart attack.

**INTERESTS:** Liudmyla loves reading and has a particular passion for Ukrainian history. She enjoys cooking, especially vegetable dishes and stuffed peppers. In the past, she often baked at home—pies, pastries, and cakes were her specialty. She has always been kind to animals and makes a habit of feeding stray cats.

We chose compassion over comfort so that the first 16 seniors would not be left on the streets. The journey was filled with ups and downs but we would do it all over again. That choice has opened the door for a \$3 million gift to house 201 more seniors this winter.

Now, only five buildings stand between us and project completion. That means a total of 217 seniors in forever homes.
